What You Need to Know About High School Classes and Graduation

- Total of 230 credits needed to graduate by the end of your senior year at Harbor
- Each semester students earn 5 credits per class
- Students need a grade of **D** or higher to pass a class
- Students should earn at least a **C grade** in all of their classes to be **College Ready**.
- If the student fails a class, they need to go to Summer School
- If students need help with any class, Harbor has an Academic
 Lab open all day where students can go in and get support
 from our Tutor Leda


